

The Czech Presidency of the Council of the European Union is delighted to welcome you to Jeseniky mountains for the **Conference Innovative Region: opportunities and challenges.**



Transportation

How to get Orea Hotel Dlouhé stráně (PRG)

By plane:

• Prague Airport, Czech Republic (252 Km). Please note that there is a joint bus form the main Railway station Prague leaving at 9. 11. 2022 10:00. Direct buses ("Airport express"; AE line; Transport to airport | Prague Public Transit Company, joint-stock company (dpp.cz)) from the airport to them main railway station run each day from 5:30 every half an hour (:00, :30). Travel time is approx. 45 minutes. The fare is 100 CZK (+/- € 4).

• There will transport to Katowice (Airport) departing from hotel Orea Hotel Dlouhé stráně at 12:00 (on 11th November).

By car:

From western part of the Czech Republic via the town of Šumperk (state roads 11 and 44), then northwards follow the state road 44 via Velké Losiny to Loučná and Desnou - Hotel Dlouhé stráně.

From eastern part of the Czech Republic (Ostrava, Moravia Silesia Region) follow the state road 11 to Petrov and Desnou, then turn right and follow the state road 44 via Velké Losiny to Loučná and Desnou - Hotel Dlouhé stráně.

Bus service will be provided by organizers for participants between meeting venues and study tours.

Study tour

The Czech Presidency organizes for the delegates a study tour. There is a possibility to choose between two options

a) Traditional Hand-made paper mill in Velké Losiny - <u>Ruční papírna Velké Losiny -</u> Historie (rpvl.cz).

The hand-made paper mill of Velké Losiny is an enterprise established at the end of the 16th century in the village of Velké Losiny in the north of the Olomouc Region. It was built by Jan Jr. of Žerotín in the places where a grain mill used to stand. The company is thus the oldest paper mill in Central Europe, which still produces paper. According to the company, other Hané paper mills were also established in other places (for example in Jindřichův, Olšany or Lukavice). During the excursion, guests will learn all about the process of paper production and interesting facts from the history of Velkolosiny paper mills. Guests will visit a number of museum expositions connected with the beginnings of paper production and an authentic ancient workplace of production.

During this study tour you will also visit a handmade quality pralines and chocolate from the workshop of Jana Kašparová, which has had several successes and confectionery is her lifelong passion. They also specialize in the production of desserts, confectionery and cakes. In the season they produce and sell their own ice cream from quality ingredients and every morning they bake fresh Velkolosinské pies with various fillings.

b) Hydroelectric power plant https://www.dlouhe-strane.cz/

The Dlouhé stráně pumped-storage hydroelectric power plant ranked among the 7 biggest wonders of the Czech Republic in 2005. It ranked among the most important Czech monuments such as Karlštejn Castle or Hluboká Castle. In the final of the voting competition it became even the biggest wonder of the Czech Republic, with 119 158 citizens voting for it. Since 2010, the upper reservoir of the Dlouhé stráně pumped-storage hydroelectric power plant is accessible by a 6-seat cable car from the nearby ski area of Kouty.

During this study tour you will visit the power plant (lecture hall - lecture, film screening), underground power plants, lower reservoir (exit by bus).



Please do not forget to take good shoes outdoor clothes if you wish to visit this hydroelectric power plant.
